



SROC HANDICAP AND SOCIAL 2019

This year, both the social and handicap take place at Leighton Hall, just like last year. It is well signed from the A6, north of its junction with the A601 (M) spur.



On arrival park in either the tennis courts or hard standing to the right of the driveway as shown on the map.

Please arrive in time to register before 12:40.

At 12:45 we will all gather together to walk to the start.

At the start you will be given your map.

After a briefing there will be a mass start as close to 1pm as we can manage.

You will each have been assigned an individual course which we expect you to complete in 35 minutes.

Lower technical difficulty courses will be assigned to juniors (yellow/orange standard as appropriate)

After the event return to your car to get changed, but remember to bring your dibber to the social for download.

Social and Prizegiving

The social will take place as soon as everyone has finished, probably around 2pm. It is in the “Tea Rooms” which are the old kitchens in the basement of the hall. These are accessed via the gardens. There are also toilets in the gardens. See plan above. Remember to bring something to eat for the Jacobs Join, and any trophies in your possession.

Competition Information

The area we are using has not been used for Orienteering for over 30 years. We are very grateful to the owners for allowing us to use the area again. N.B, It is different to last year's area!

The map is brand new, surveyed and drawn to ISOM2017 standards and using (mostly) Lidar contours. See the legend to the right. The area is typical limestone area so lots of rock features including large (i.e. dangerous) crags, boulder fields and stony limestone areas. Beware when crossing these especially when wet. Where courses pass close to dangerous crags these will be marked with yellow and black tape. There is an extensive area of stony ground plus slow run forest which most courses will encounter. It is crossable with care, but slow going. Only boulders 1m or higher have been mapped.

There is one control on a charcoal burning platform, shown on the map as a brown triangle and as a triangle with a circle round it on the description list.

There are a number of walls and fences on the area which should not be crossed. Courses are planned to allow you to use gates or crossing points. Some breaks in walls are marked as crossing points and will be shown with red and white tape.

When you finish please report to the finish official to have your name crossed off the list.

Anyone who wants to take a second run round the area to collect controls please let me know and bring an empty rucksack with you to the start.

It would help us if you contact the organiser in advance if you do not currently have a BOF ranking, you got a new dibber for Christmas, or you have invited a non-SROC friend to come to the event! Please email Alex Finch (alex@finchfamily.org.uk) in these cases.
